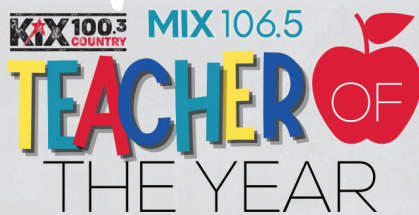

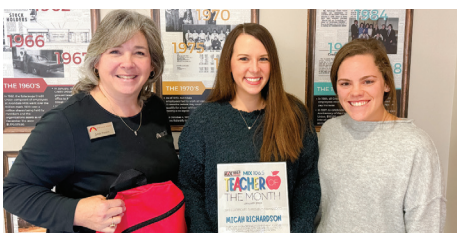

STEP 1

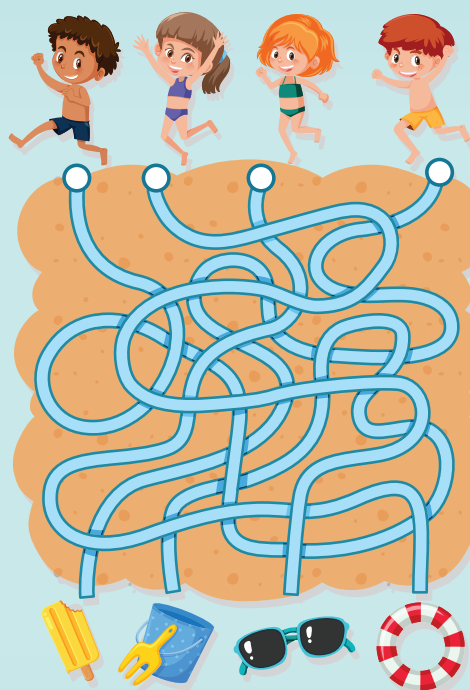
Tap "Accounts" in your app dashboard. Choose an account.

STEP 2

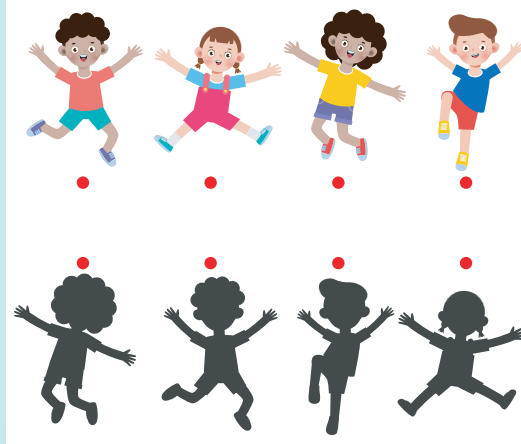
Go to "Card Management" and choose a card.
