It was spring break 1998, my mom and I walked into New Horizon Credit Union in Midtown Mobile, Alabama. I had just turned 16 a few months prior and I was ready to purchase my first car. I had saved up \$1000 from various part-time jobs and my parents said they would match it. The loan officer informed me it would be better for me to build some credit rather than empty the account out. She suggested a share secured loan that would allow me to take care of both my needs. I didn't really know what she was talking about, all I knew was I had to pay \$100 dollars a month for almost two years.

I had completely forgotten that story until last week when I had Mary in my office. She was driving a pickup older than me and it was on its last leg. She also told me since her husband had left, her credit was "less than perfect". She was working a minimum wage job and she was certain she wouldn't qualify for a loan but was desperate, nonetheless. After discussing her budget and expenses, I noticed Mary had just received a large refund from the IRS. I asked her what she was going to do with that money. She then let me know her house was falling apart too. She was hoping to stretch the money enough for a down payment for a used car, fix the house and catch up on some bills.

It was so exciting that almost 20 years later I had come full circle and was able to work out a plan for her to use her refund as security on a loan to help rebuild her credit. We got online and looked up some reliable used cars that she was going to check out and lastly I even helped recommend a few honest contractors. When she left my office she was nearly in tears.

Two years ago when I started at Heritage South, I was reading our credit union philosophy, "People Helping People"; and even though I understood and agreed, it wasn't until last week that I got to experience it. I am so proud to be able to serve our membership. If you want to discuss your specific financial needs, my door is always open.


